

## Who's a Star?



### Domain:

- Socialization, Language, Cognitive

### Objectives:

- Child will identify classmates by picture.
- Child will match classmate pictures.
- Child will identify object as star.

### Materials:

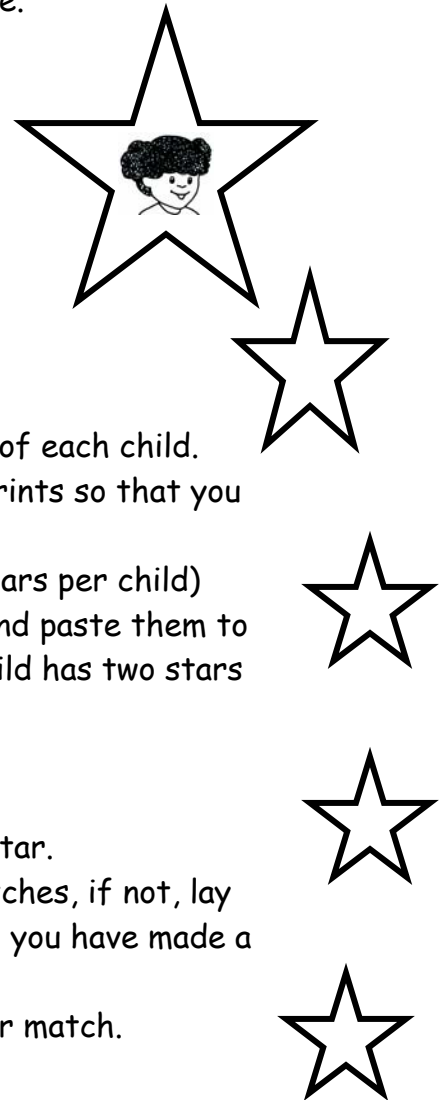
- *Who's a Star?* reproducible page
- Yellow construction paper
- Camera, film

### Instructions:

- Teacher will take a close-up face shot of each child.
- Have film developed. Request double prints so that you have 2 pictures of each child.
- Teacher will copy *Who's a Star?* (2 stars per child)
- Teacher will cut photo's if necessary and paste them to the back of the stars so that every child has two stars and each star has an identical picture.
- Lay stars face down on the floor.
- Turn one card up.
- Have children identify who is on that star.
- Turn over another star to see if it matches, if not, lay star face down again and continue until you have made a match.
- Continue until all stars have found their match.

### Suggestion:

- Laminate for durability.
- Place stiff Velcro on the top of the picture side of the star and use with felt board or Velcro board instead of putting stars on the floor.
- Use written names in addition to photos.
