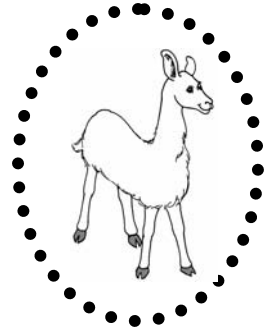


## A Pocket for My Kangaroo

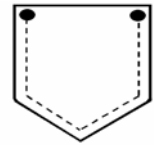


### Domain:

- Fine Motor

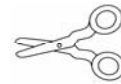
### Objectives:

- Child will cut pocket pieces.
- Child will paste pocket pieces together.
- Child will thread lace through holes.
- Child will place kangaroo in pocket.



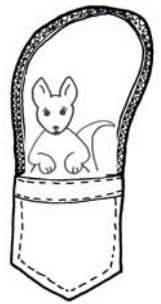
### Materials:

- *A Pocket for My Kangaroo* reproducible page
- Scissors
- Paper punch
- Ribbon, string, or yarn

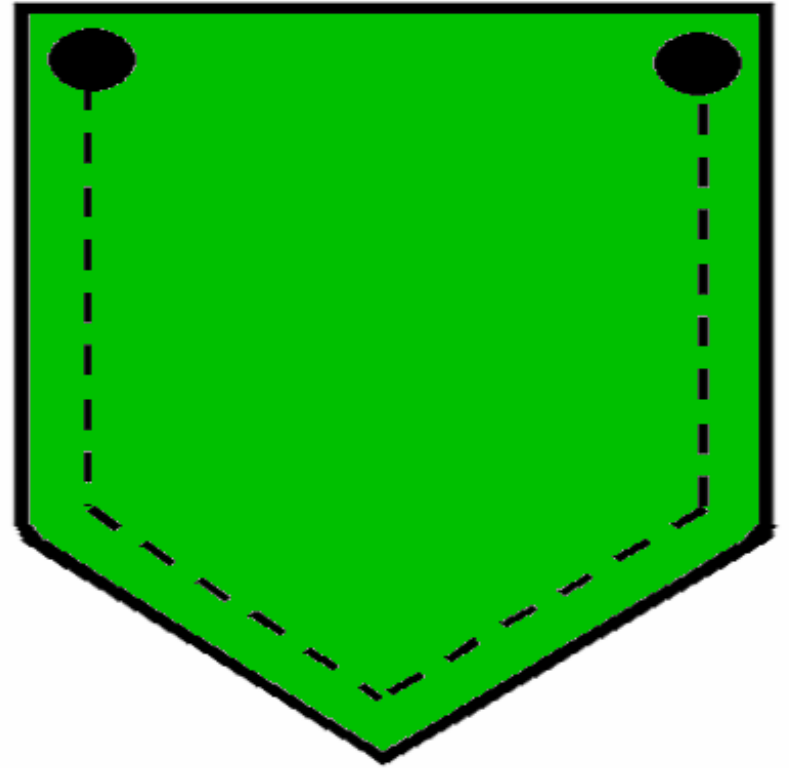
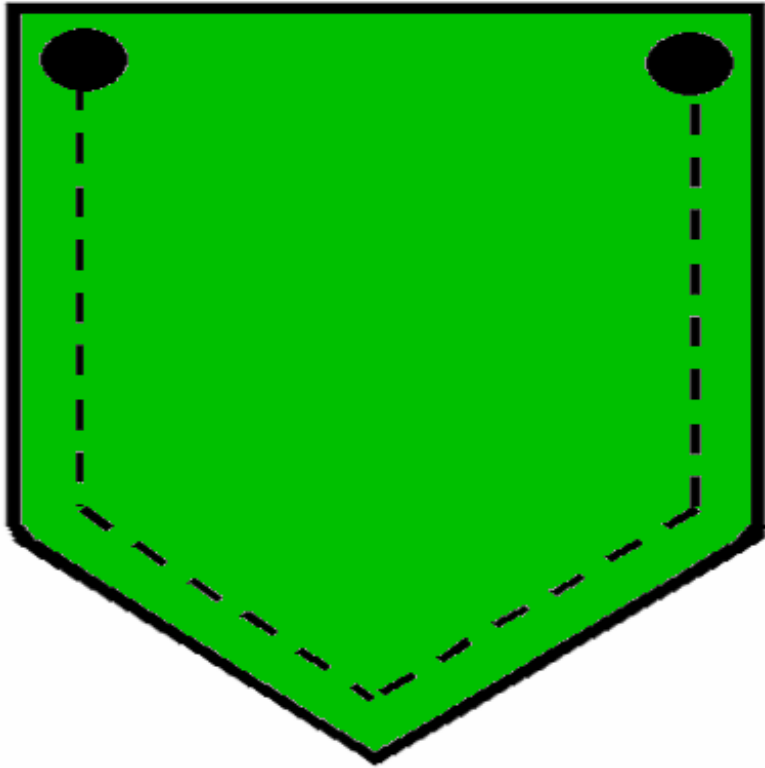


### Instructions:

- Copy *A Pocket for My Kangaroo*.
- Depending on child's ability level, cut or instruct child to cut out both pockets and kangaroo oval.
- Paste pockets together around the edges leaving the top open.
- Use a paper punch to punch two holes on the black dots at the top of the pocket.
- Measure and cut approximately 20 inches of yarn, ribbon or string for each child.
- Instruct child to thread ribbon, yarn or string through the holes.
- Tie ribbon or string at the top.
- Place kangaroo in the pocket.
- Have children put ribbon and pocket over their head to wear similar to a necklace.
- Encourage children to hop in imitation of the mama kangaroo.
