

Paddling to Shore



Domain:

- Language, Cognitive

Objectives:

- Child will repeat familiar rhyming words or phrases.
- Child will count the number of ducks.

Materials:

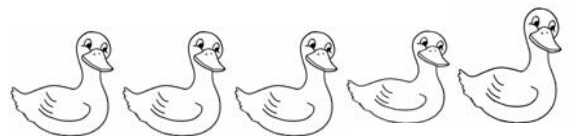
- *Paddling to Shore* duck pattern
- scissors
- yellow construction paper
- Velcro

Instructions:

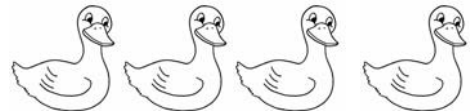
- Copy five of the *Paddling to Shore* duck patterns onto yellow construction paper.
- Laminate and place Velcro onto the back of the ducks.
- Place five ducks in a row on flannel board or Velcro board.
- Count the ducks
- Recite poem written below.
- Each time a duck paddles away, remove a duck from the board.
- Recount the ducks and continue with the next verse.

Paddling to Shore:

Five little ducks paddling to shore.
One paddled away, and then there were four.



Four little ducks paddling toward me,
One paddled away, and then there were three.



Three little ducks paddling towards you,
One paddled away, and then there were two.



Two little ducks paddling in the sun,
One paddled away, and then there was one.

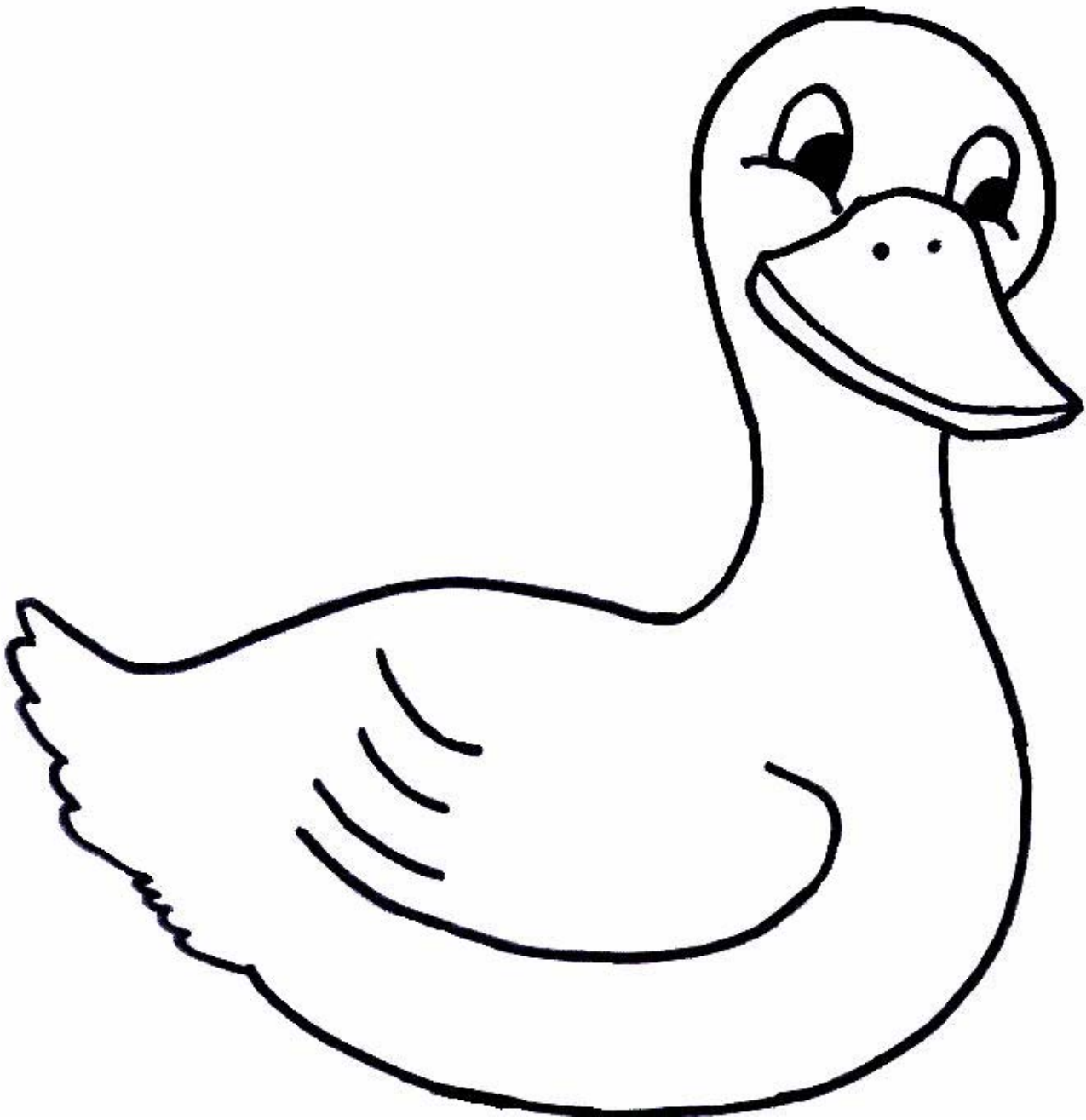


One little duck, paddling for fun,
