- As forms are returned to school, let children share information about what they did to help at home.

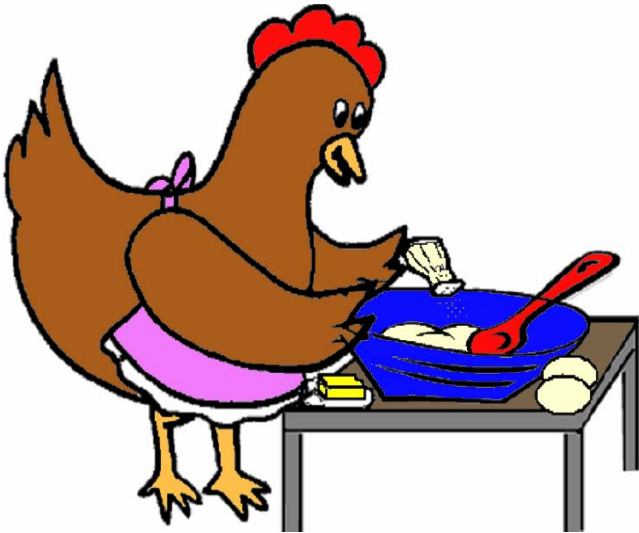
Suggestions
