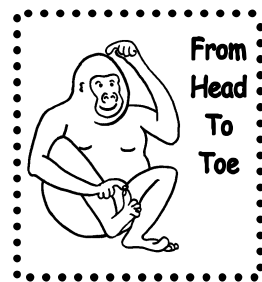


Cardboard Roll Puppets



Domain:

- Language, Socialization

Objectives:

- Child will identify animal.
- Child will use puppet as supplemental prop for the story.

Materials:

- toilet paper rolls
- construction paper
- markers or crayons
- scissors
- glue



Directions:

- Teacher will copy and cut a set of animals for each child. (pp. 86-90)
- Teacher will present animals to child and review animals by name.
- Teacher will cut and write names on nametags. (pp. 91)
- Teacher will cut 4X6 inch strips of construction paper. (pp. 92)
- Assist child to select and count eleven cardboard rolls.
- Assist child to select and count eleven strips of construction paper.
- Assist child to paste a strip of construction paper over cardboard roll.
- Assist child to color each animal the appropriate color.
- Assist child to paste animal to covered cardboard roll.
- Assist child to paste nametag on finished cardboard roll puppet.
- Allow children to use puppets to participate during story time.

Suggestions:

- This activity can be done over a several day span.
- For ease in preparation you may choose to use the *From Head to Toe* colored CD to print colored animals.
- Children with advanced cutting skills should be allowed to cut their own animals and construction paper strips.
