

## Match It, Count It, Eat It Place Mat



### Domain:

- Cognitive, Self-Help

### Objectives:

- Child will demonstrate number concepts 1-3.
- Child will match bears to appropriate numbers.
- Child will count appropriate number of Teddy Graham cookies.
- Child will consume edible bears after completing activity.

### Materials:

- *Match It, Count It, Eat It* work page/place mat
- construction paper
- plastic teddy counters (red, blue, green)
- Teddy Graham cookies

### Instructions:

- Teacher will copy *Match It, Count It, Eat It* work page/place mat.
- Instruct child to put finger on rectangle that shows one bear.
- Instruct child to choose only one plastic counting bear to place on the bear in the first rectangle. Continue to the second rectangle and do the same with two bears and again in the third rectangle with three bears.
- Use Teddy Grahams the last time the children are asked to match and count. When counting is complete, invite the children to eat the bears.

### Suggestions:

- Gummy Bears could also be used with this activity.
- For variation, repeat using only red bears, then only blue bears and finally only green bears.
- Laminate place mat so that it can be washed and reused.
