

Under My Hat



Domain:

- Socialization, Language, Cognitive

Objectives:

- Child will take turns during group activity.
- Child will identify objects as hats and blocks
- Child will remember which hat the block is under.

Materials:

- Three (or more) cone shaped clown hats similar to the one pictured in the story.
- One block with the letter "H".



Instructions:

- Place two hats in front of the children. One of the hats will have the "H" block hidden under it.
- Pick up each hat one at a time. Let them see where the "H" block is hiding.
- Put both hats back in original position with the "H" block under one.
- Give each student a chance to tell you which hat is hiding the "H" block.
- When children have mastered playing the game with two hats, add a third hat and repeat the process.
- Add hats as necessary.

Suggestions:

- Clown hats can easily be made by rolling a large piece of construction paper into a cone. Trim the bottom edge and paste on pom-poms.
