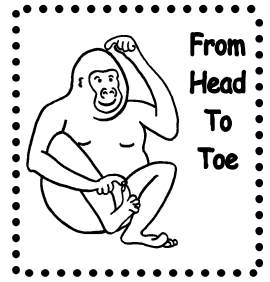


You Did I t!

Objectives:

- Child will demonstrate satisfaction when completing a task, solving a problem, or making a discovery.
- Child will demonstrate pride in accomplishments.
- Child will describe work or accomplishments.

Materials:

- *You Did I t!* reward certificates

Instructions:

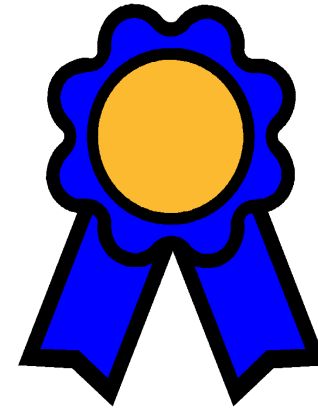
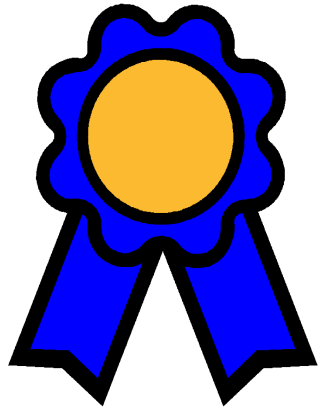
- Reproduce several copies of *You Did I t!* certificates to keep on hand for teacher use throughout the day.
- Present a certificate to a child as an immediate visual reward for a task well done to reinforce positive efforts.

Suggestions:

- Use a safety pin to attach certificate to child's clothing.
- Send certificate home with child.
- Display certificate on bulletin board along with child's picture and name.
- Allow child to select which certificate he/she prefers.
- Allow child to accumulate certificates throughout the week and display on the bulletin board.
- Write a short note on the certificate to remind teacher, child and parent why the child received the reward.
