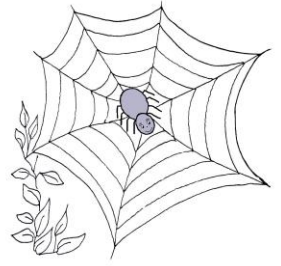


Five Little Spiders

One spun a web then there were three.



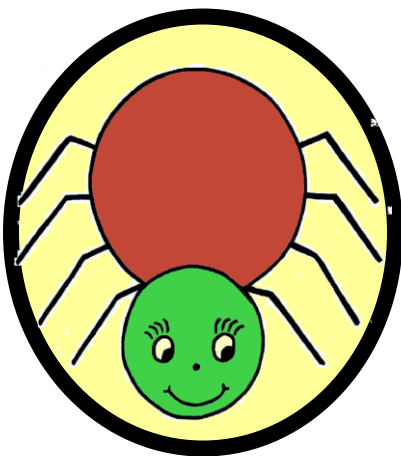
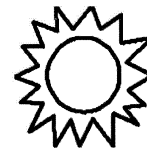
Three little spiders landed on a shoe,

One spun a web and then there was one.



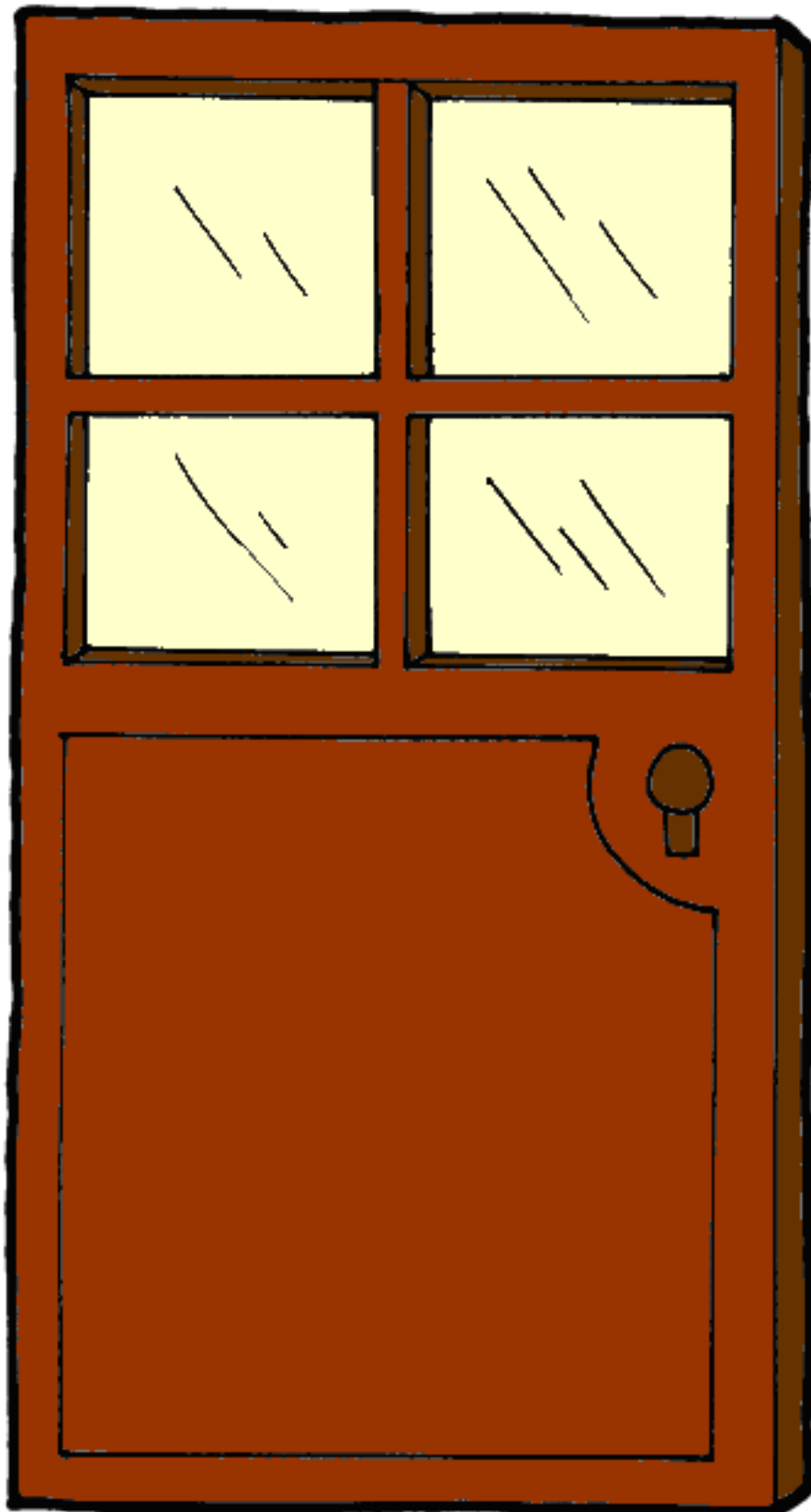
One little spider sitting in the sun,

- When reciting the rhyme, remove one spider as indicated in the rhyme, and place it on the empty spider web. (Use Velcro to attach)

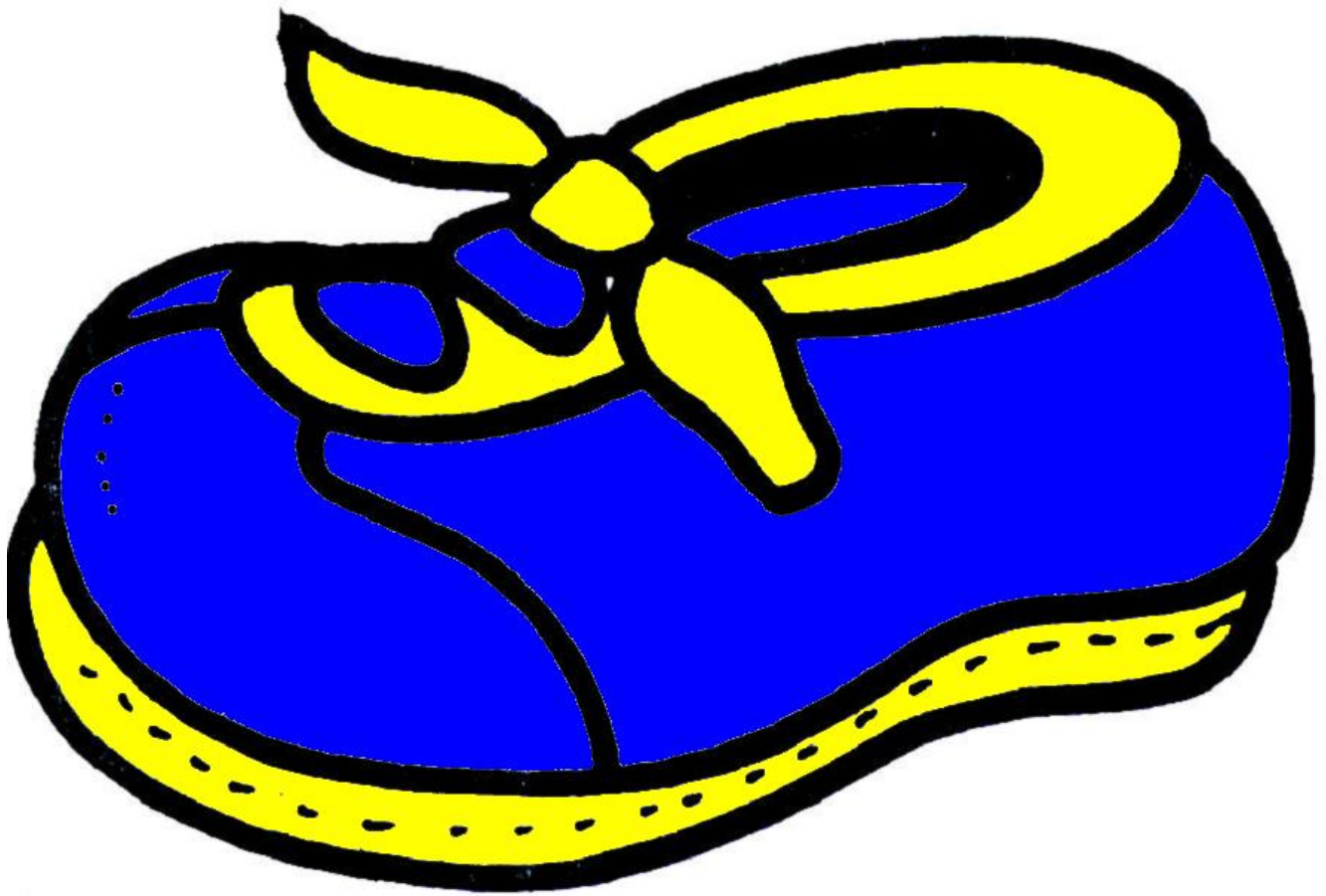
