



2. Repeat Four Word Sentence	Teacher: Say these four words: "I see the car." Child is instructed to repeat the sentence. Teacher says all 4 words. Child's response: _____			
3. Segmentation	  	Teacher: Tell the child the beginning sequence without using cards, then mix up cards. "Can you put these cards in the right order so it makes sense?" Child's response: _____		
4. Visual Discrimination		Teacher: Show the child the cards with the letters R, P and K. Hold up the large card with the letter K and ask, "Match the one that looks the same as mine." Child's response: _____		
5. Shape Identification		Teacher: Touch each shape and ask, "What shape is this?" Child's response: _____		
6. Color Identification		Teacher: Touch each color and ask, "What color is this?" Child's response: _____		
7. Numerical Identification		Teacher: Touch each number and ask, "What number is this?" Child's response: _____

Assessment Part 1

Questions 1-15 on this assessment are based on foundational skills found in Read It Once Again **Level 1** units. **Level 1** units provide language based activities organized into these five domains:

- Speech and Language
- Cognitive
- Motor
- Daily Living
- Socialization

Assessment Part 2

Questions 16-20 assess the child's application and generalization of the specific foundational skills. These skills refer to our Read It Once Again **Level 2** units which provide language based activities organized into these five domains:

- Phonemic Awareness
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies
- Creative Writing

Both **Level 1** and **Level 2** units contain activities based on preschool milestones. **Level 1** units provide activities addressing foundational skills that are a prerequisite for success in **Level 2** units which require more advanced language skills.
