



Caterpillar Days of the Week

Domain:

- Reading and Language

Goals:

- Child will identify the sight words for the days of the week.
- Child will match the foods eaten by the caterpillar according to the days of the week.
- Child will sequence the days of the week in correct order.
- Child will count the number of fruits eaten.
- Child will repeat familiar words and phrases.

Materials:

- *Caterpillar Days of the Week* Identification Cards pp. 138-139
- card stock or durable paper
- color CD
- scissors
- lamination

Instructions:

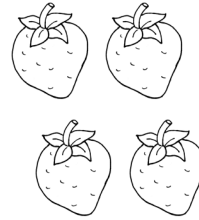
- Print *Caterpillar Days of the Week* from color CD.
- Laminate for durability.
- Cut individual *Caterpillar Days of the Week* strips.
- The *Caterpillar Days of the Week* identification cards can be used in a variety of ways. The goal is for the child to identify the sight word for each day of the week.
- The *Caterpillar Days of the Week* cards can be used at calendar or circle time as a way to identify the name of the day.
- The *Caterpillar Days of the Week* cards can be used during story time to help children sequence which foods were eaten on a particular day.
- The *Caterpillar Days of the Week* cards can be used with this song to teach sight words for days of the week, and sequencing.

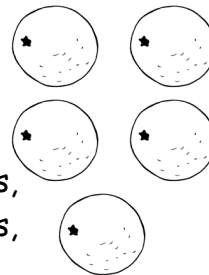

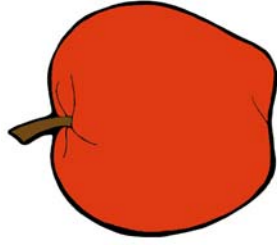

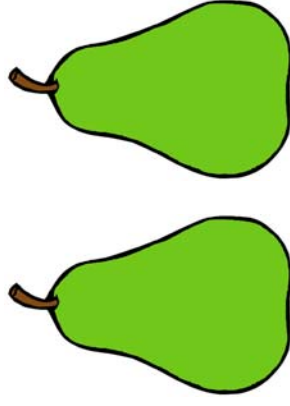
Suggestions:

- Combine song lyrics with *Caterpillar Days of the Week* cards to make a classroom book.

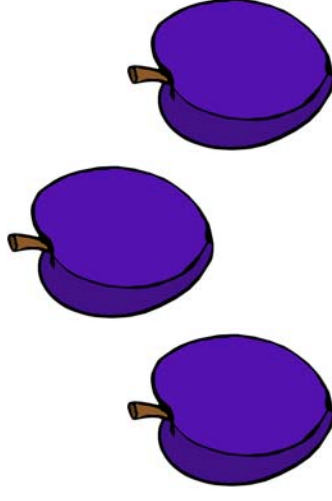
